CURRICULUM VITAE

Fabrizio Jacobacci has received a law degree from the Faculty of Law of the University of Turin. He has worked with the German law firm Pünder, Volhard, Weber & Axter (now Clifford Chance) in Frankfurt in 1988 and has subsequently worked with Linklaters in London in 1989. He has returned to Italy where he has worked with Studio Legale Vietti whose founding partner was Deputy Minister of Justice. He founded his own firm in 1996, Studio Legale Jacobacci & Associati, an Intellectual Property boutique firm which currently has five partners and twenty-five associates. Fabrizio is the senior partner of the firm.



Fabrizio has authored several articles in the matter of intellectual property, including “Damages as a Remedy for Trademark Infringement in Italy”, the Journal of Proprietary Rights, Vol. 7, No. 1, January 1995, “Importazioni Parallele ed Esaurimento del Diritto di Marchio”, Torino, 2000; he is a member of the editorial board of the “European Trademark Reports” published by Sweet & Maxwell. He is currently contributing to a publication in the field of pharmaceutical and biotechnology patents.

Fabrizio is a frequent speaker at international conferences in intellectual property matters, including the Intellectual Property Section of the New York State Bar Association, the International Trademark Association and the International Bar Association.
